STATUTORY DECLARATION


HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 31 (6)

I AVERIL HAROLD DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 23 February 1999 the owner of the land known as Bickershaw, Wigan/Hindley more particularly delineated on the Plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 17 of August 1999 the Woodland Trust deposited with Wigan Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that:
 - the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths
 - no other ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 17 August 1999 referred to in 2 above [other than those footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 15 day of June 2009
conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory
Declarations Act 1835.


